Course of Studies under Faculty Councils of Science & Arts is 50% at the Honours level in the concerned/relevant subject (As per Course/Program wise Qualifying Bachelor Degree, mentioned below) from a UGC recognised University. For candidates belonging to SC/ ST/ OBC-A/ OBC-B/ DA/ SP/ EWS categories, eligibility is minimum of 45% marks in honours in the concerned/relevant subject (As per Course/Program wise Qualifying Bachelor Degree, mentioned below).

GRADE POINT (GP) CALCULATION

FOR ALL COURSE/ PROGRAMS

GRADE POINT (GP) = 20% of Percentage marks (based on the marks of the best 05 (five) subjects : Full marks 100 each) obtained in the 10th Standard Examination + 20% of Percentage marks (based on the marks of the best 04 (four) subjects : Full marks 100 each) obtained in the 12th Standard Examination + 60% of Percentage marks (based on Honours/ Major Subject only) obtained in the Qualifying Bachelor Degree

SELECTION PROCEDURE

FOR SUBJECTS OTHER THAN MULTIDISCIPLINARY SUBJECTS:

80% of the total Intake for Pass outs of B.U. Students:

80% of the total intake of seats will be reserved exclusively for the pass-outs from the Under- Graduate Colleges affiliated to the University of Burdwan. Admission to these seats will be offered strictly on the basis of Grade Points to be calculated by adding 60% of Percentage marks (based on Honours/ Major Subject only) obtained in the Qualifying Bachelor Degree with 20% of Percentage marks (based on the marks of the best 04 (four) subjects : Full marks 100 each) obtained in the HS or equivalent examinations' and 20% of Percentage marks (based on the marks of the best 05 (five) subjects : Full marks 100 each) obtained in the Madhyamik or equivalent examinations'. In case of the equal Grade Points, the percentage

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of marks obtained by the candidate in Honours/ Major subject is to be considered and calculated for determining the higher position in the merit list. In case of the uniform score in the concerned Honours/ Major subject, the percentage of marks obtained by the candidate in Higher Secondary Examination is to be considered and calculated for determining the higher position in the merit list. If the percentage of Higher Secondary marks is also being the same, percentage of Secondary Examination will be considered for ranking. If, at all these stages, performances of more than one student are found to be same, then final decision regarding selection of candidate will be referred to Hon'ble Vice Chancellor, BU.

20% of total Intake for Pass outs of Other University Students:

Remaining 20% of the seats will be filled up on the basis of Grade Points to be calculated by adding 60% of Percentage marks (based on Honours/ Major Subject only) obtained in the Qualifying Bachelor Degree with 20% of Percentage marks (based on the marks of the best 04 (four) subjects : Full marks 100 each) obtained in the HS or equivalent examinations' and 20% of Percentage marks (based on the marks of the best 05 (five) subjects : Full marks 100 each) obtained in the Madhyamik or equivalent examinations' from the applicants from Universities other than The University of Burdwan. In case of the equal Grade Points, the percentage of marks obtained by the candidate in Honours/ Major subject is to be considered and calculated for determining the higher position in the merit list. In case of the uniform score in the concerned Honours/ Major subject, the percentage of marks obtained by the candidate in Higher Secondary Examination is to be considered and calculated for determining the higher position in the merit list. If the percentage of Higher Secondary marks is also being the same, percentage of Secondary Examination will be considered for ranking. If, at all these stages, performances of more than one student are found to be same, then final decision regarding selection of candidate will be referred to Hon'ble Vice Chancellor, BU.

For admission to M.Sc in Statistics:

The 80% seat of total intake will be filled up by the students of Home University and the rest 20% seat will be filled up preferably by the students having Bachelor Degree with Statistics Honours form Other Universities. For 80% seat Category (Home University), 50% seat will be reserved for the candidates having Bachelor Degree with Statistics Honours and rest 50% of Seat will be reserved by the candidates having Bachelor Degree with Mathematics Honours.

Rest of the procedure will remain same as for **subjects other than multidisciplinary subjects.**

FOR MULTIDISCIPLINARY SUBJECTS

Seats in the multidisciplinary subject seats will be filled up on the basis of **Grade Points**. Multidisciplinary subject, the Grade Points to be calculated by adding 60% of Percentage marks (based on Honours/ Major Subject only) obtained in the Qualifying Bachelor Degree with 20% of Percentage marks (based on the marks of the best 04 (four) subjects : Full marks 100 each) obtained in the HS or equivalent examinations' and 20% of Percentage marks (based on the marks of the best 05 (five) subjects : Full marks 100 each) obtained in the Madhyamik or equivalent

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examinations'. In case of the equal Grade Points, the percentage of marks obtained by the candidate in Honours/ Major subject is to be considered and calculated for determining the higher position in the merit list. In case of the uniform score in the concerned Honours/ Major subject, the percentage of marks obtained by the candidate in Higher Secondary Examination is to be considered and calculated for determining the higher position in the merit list. If the percentage of Higher Secondary marks is also being the same, percentage of Secondary Examination will be considered for ranking. If, at all these stages, performances of more than one student are found to be same, then final decision regarding selection of candidate will be referred to Hon'ble Vice Chancellor, BU.

- For admission in **M.Sc in Environmental Science**, the following rule will be adhered while preparing the list of selected candidates:
 1. 60% of the total seats will be earmarked for honours students in Environmental Science from the affiliated colleges of the University of Burdwan.
 2. 40% of the total seats will be earmarked from other relevant subjects mentioned under eligibility criteria.
- For admission in **M.Sc in Biotechnology**, five (05) seats will be earmarked under Unreserved category for applicants with honours in Biotechnology from colleges under the University of Burdwan.

RESERVATION GUIDELINES

Seats for candidates belonging to various categories (22% for SC, 6% for ST, 10% for OBCA, 7% for OBCB and 10% for EWS of total seats) are reserved as per the directives of the Government of West Bengal. Further, D.A. candidates will enjoy a 5% reservation in each of the categories, i.e. in SC, ST, OBC-A, OBC-B and in the Unreserved or UR category as per the Rules framed by the Government of West Bengal.

The entire process of admission to the PG Programmes 2025 for candidates under reserved categories shall remain subject to, and be governed by, the orders and directions of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India and/or the Hon'ble High Court at Calcutta, as may be applicable and pending before them.

It will entirely be the responsibility of the candidate to prove his/her eligibility in terms of minimum educational qualifications and for claiming reservation under a specific category, if any, at the time of admission.

FOR SCHEDULE CASTE & SCHEDULE TRIBES CANDIDATES:

Reservation for SC/ST candidates for admission will be as per reservation rules vide Govt. Order No.: 07-Edn (U)/1U-89/13.- dated. 2nd January, 2014 "for admission to different courses, an SC or ST candidate getting admission should have obtained in the previous examination; qualifying marks not lower by more than 25% of the marks obtained by the last candidate of the general category." Relevant Certificate must conform to West Bengal Govt. Memo No. 1813-BCW/MR-94/11 dated 20th June, 2011. Candidates claiming reservation against SC/ST (relevant certificate is required) quota of seats must submit relevant caste certificates issued in their favour by one of the authorities listed below:

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- Deputy Collector of Land Revenue,
- Kolkata Collector of Stamp Revenue,
- Kolkata Metropolitan Magistrate, Kolkata,
- Addl. Chief Metropolitan Magistrate, Kolkata,
- Chief Metropolitan Magistrate, Kolkata,
- 1st Class Stipendiary Magistrate,
- Executive Magistrate,
- Sub-Divisional Magistrate,
- Sub-Divisional Officer,
- Deputy Collector,
- Addl. District Magistrate,
- Collector and District Magistrate within the irrespective jurisdictions in case of candidates claiming to be Schedule Caste or Schedule Tribe and ordinarily residing within such jurisdictions.

FOR OBC-A AND OBC-B CANDIDATES:

Reservation for OBC-A/OBC-B candidates for admission will be as per reservation rules vide Govt. Order No.: 07-Edn (U)/1U-89/13.- dated. 2nd January, 2014 “for admission to different courses, an OBCA or OBCB candidate getting admission should have obtained in the previous examination; qualifying marks not lower by more than 10% of the marks obtained by the last candidate of the general category.”. The West Bengal Higher Educational Institutions (The Reservation in Admissions) Act, 2013 enacted by Govt. of West Bengal has opened the opportunity for the students belonging to OBC-A and OBC-B (as determined and notified by Backward Classes Welfare Department, Govt. of West Bengal) for reservation of seats in higher education in the state. The communities listed by the Department of Backward Classes Welfare, Govt. of West Bengal as OBC-A and OBC-B would get the benefit of reservation

For Differently Abled (DA Category) Candidates:

The candidates seeking admission under this category must produce a valid certificate issued by an appropriate authority not below the rank of Superintendent of Sub-Divisional Hospital. In the certificate, the mentioned extent of Physical Disability must not be less than 40%. APPLICANTS WHO HAVE SECURED LESS THAN 50% MARKS WILL BE DISQUALIFIED IF THEY FAIL TO QUALIFY FOR THE SEATS UNDER THIS CATEGORY.

FOR SPORTS PERSONALITY (SP CATEGORY) CATEGORY CANDIDATES:

Sports quota will be available in Burdwan University Campus only for the candidates who have passed out from the University of Burdwan in graduation level, seeking admission under 80% category. Candidates applying for admission against Sports (SP) Category of seats must have to submit certificates for their participation in National or Inter-University Sports and Athletic competitions (not earlier than Madhyamik level) and representing the University team in AIU Games as per AIU norms. If more than 01 (One) candidate applies under SP Category in any particular subject/program, then the applicant having higher marks in Grade Point (GP) will be selected under SP Category. The intake under SP Category will be guided by the resolution of the meeting of the Executive Council, held on 07.12.2021 (Item No. – 291 (AOM))

FOR EWS CATEGORY CANDIDATES:

Reservation for EWS candidates for admission will be as per reservation rules vide Govt. Order No.: **339-Edn (CS)/OM-74L/2023 - dated. 26th May, 2023**, issued by Department of Higher Education, 6th Floor, Bikash Bhavan, Kolkata-91. Candidates claiming reservation against EWS Category (relevant certificate is required) quota of seats must submit the relevant EWS certificates issued in their favour by one of the authorities as per O.M. No. 325-PAR (AR)/3P-1/2019 dated 09.07.2019 of Personnel & Administrative Reforms, Govt. Of West Bengal and Memo No. 959-BCW/MR-52/2019 dated 18.05.2023 of Backward Classes Welfare Department, Govt. Of West Bengal.

GUIDELINES FOR ADMISSION OF INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS

The University of Burdwan offers admission to foreign nationals under self- financed basis by following UGC guidelines for admission and supernumerary seats of international students in various Under-graduate and Post Graduate courses of studies and also to pursue Doctor of Philosophy (Ph.D.).

ICCR APPLICANTS

The ICCR applicants are nominated/sponsored by Government of India under various Scholarship Schemes of the Indian Council for Cultural Relations (ICCR).

Candidates are advised to contact the nearest Indian Diplomatic Mission for necessary information about these scholarships.

FOREIGN STUDENTS AND NRIS

Foreign students and NRIs may take admission to this University on **self- financed basis** upon fulfilling eligibility criteria of the programme of their choice. Minimum eligibility qualifications for foreign students will be the same as is for Indian Students for each course/program which is determined by the University authority from time to time. Admission to such candidates shall be offered following necessary approval of the University authority and in compliance of the guidelines in force of the University Grants Commission (UGC) for admission and supernumerary seats of International Students in various courses in Higher Educational Institutions in India. Applicants seeking admission on self-finance basis are advised to keep in touch with the official website of the University **www.buruniv.ac.in** and send their applications to **International Student' Cell** accordingly.

GUIDELINES AND RULES FOR ADMISSION

1. Minimum eligibility criteria for admission of foreign students will be the same as is for Indian Students for each course as is determined by the University authority following the guidelines of Ministry of Education;
2. English translation of all transcripts, duly attested, is to be submitted along with application;
3. Applications without the attested documents shall be summarily rejected;
4. The admission criteria of the foreign students who want to pursue courses of their choice on self-financed basis shall be determined by the University authority;
5. On being granted admission, all applicants must produce their valid Passport and Students Visa issued for pursuing the respective course;
6. Foreign students are to produce AIDS Certificate from both the Governments (India and the Country from which the candidates intend to prosecute their studies here);
7. Students are to produce Resident Permit from the Superintendent of Police/Registration Officer, DIB of the locality in West Bengal, India;

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8. 'No Objection Certificate' from the Ministry of Education, Govt. of the Country from which the candidate intends to come is to be produced by the students;
9. Any other valid documents as may be required for Foreign Students from time to time as per orders of the Govt. or the University Authority are to be submitted by the Students;
10. Upon arrival in India every Foreign Students must register with the Foreigners Regional Registration Office (FRRO) within fourteen (14) days from the date of first entry inside India as per prescribed applicable procedure as laid down by Government of India;
11. The course/program once filled in the application form shall be final and cannot be changed at any later stage. Once admitted, all foreign students shall pay the fee as per prescribed fees structure of the University for Foreign Students. However, the University may revise the fee at any time subject to approval of the appropriate authority.

FEES AND SCHOLARSHIP

For any query regarding the academic fees, course fee, hostel charges etc., the students are to contact the office of the International Students' Cell during office hours.

ACCOMMODATION

The University has a dedicated state-of-the-art International Students' Hostel in the campus for accommodation facility extended to the International Students. The Hostel charges for accommodation are on actual basis or as may be determined by the University authority from time to time.

BANKING

International Students on ICCR fellowship are required to open Savings Bank Account at the State Bank of India, Burdwan University Branch. International Students admitting themselves on self –financed basis can open Savings Bank Account at the said Bank and Branch.

Apart from the above requirements the incumbent foreign students are to keep in touch with the International Student Cell throughout their stay in this University. The International students Cell extends its assistance to the Students/Scholars from overseas in admission process and monitors their activities, maintains liaisons with the sponsoring agencies and extends all sorts of co-operation to the students round the clock and takes care of their problems, if any, faced by them. IMPORTANT INSTRUCTIONS TO BE FOLLOWED WHILE FILLING UP THE APPLICATION FORM

1. Candidates are required to enter percentage marks of the best FIVE subjects (100 marks each) at the 10th Standard Examination.

3. Candidates are required to enter the percentage of marks obtained in Honours/Major subject only, excluding pass/general subjects. Calculate the percentage using only the marks obtained in Honours/Major papers, as specified by the university or college rules. Do not enter the total or aggregate percentage including pass subjects. If the Honours/Major marks are provided in CGPA (Cumulative Grade Point Average), candidate must convert the CGPA into percentage as per the university's official conversion rule. Convert and enter the percentage of CGPA related to Honours subjects only, not the overall CGPA including pass/general papers.

Once the application form is submitted, no request for change of preference of Centre of Studies will be entertained in any circumstances. Candidates are therefore advised to give their Preference of Centre of Studies carefully.
