“Session for merit-based selection/allotment of candidates for subjects offered through single and multiple centre of learning”

Subjects [Arabic, Bengali, Commerce, English, Education, Economics, Hindi, History, Political Science, Philosophy, Santhali, Sanskrit, Sociology, MLIS, LLM, M. Ed., Mass Communication and MBA programmes] offered in different centres of learning (BU campus and affiliated Colleges)

All the eligible candidates of the aforementioned subjects who have applied for admission (with successful submission status) to the various PG courses offered by single/multiple centres of learning (i.e., Golapbag campus and affiliated colleges where PG courses are conducted) under the Faculty Council (Arts) of BU for the session 2020-2022, are asked to attend the session **positively** for merit-based selection as per the following schedule:

The candidates should take note of the following instructions:

1. The session is being conducted **only** for merit-based selection/allotment of candidates based on **eligibility and merit criteria**.
2. **The mere fact that a candidate has been asked to appear in the session doesn't assure selection unless seats are available. Hence all candidates are asked to check the subject-wise vacancy position before attending the session.**
3. The session will be conducted under strict COVID-19 protocol.
4. Document verification will be carried out later on by the concerned department where the candidates will be selected after the conclusion of the session and after payment of admission fees through on-line mode for the respective centre of learning.
5. **All eligible candidates as per the serial nos. mentioned above** who have successfully submitted application forms online and who intend to study in single/multiple centres of learning to be allotted based on merit, should **compulsorily attend** the session.
6. In case a candidate is unable to attend, he/she should send his/her **authorised representative** for the session.
7. Once the merit-based selection is completed, payment link for payment of the requisite admission fees will be available for the selected candidates through the online link from **02.03.2021** and will be live upto midnight of **09.03.2021**. In case of any issue/problem regarding payment, candidates should contact us immediately and definitely before the expiry of payment period (email: pgadmissionarts2019@buruniv.ac.in). No communication in this regard will be entertained after the expiry of payment period.
8. Candidates will be enlisted based on the merit-based selection on the basis of the vacancy position.
9. The selected candidates should report to their respective departments with the e-receipt of their admission Fees on or one day after the payment of admission fees.
10. All the selected candidates who have successfully paid the admission fees will have to produce and submit self-attested photocopies of **all** testimonials including the relevant certificates and final honours mark sheet **on the date of document verification**, failing which their admission to Post Graduate courses will be cancelled. All eligibility criteria will be checked during document verification. If, at the time of document verification, the marks

obtained by the candidate doesn't match with the marks shown in the merit list, the admission of the candidate is liable to be cancelled.

11. The broad rank list has been prepared based on system generated data without actual document verification. Candidates are therefore requested to verify their eligibility in accordance with the criteria as prescribed in the Information Brochure of the PG Admission 2020, available in the University Website.
12. ALL ADMISSIONS ARE PROVISIONAL. Mere selection of candidates and payment of admission fees do not ensure confirmation of admission unless the eligibility of the candidates is checked and original credentials are found in order at the time of verification of documents. If a candidate is found, before or after admission, not having the minimum eligibility of admission, then the university will have the right to cancel his/her admission without taking responsibility of refund of his/her admission fees. The University also reserves all rights to drop or to include any name, if any suppression of facts on the part of the students, any mistake on the part of the University or any error in the system-generated data is detected at any stage before or after the admission.
13. In case a candidate does not fulfil the eligibility and merit criteria, he/she is requested not to proceed with the subsequent steps since it is likely that the admission will not be confirmed.
14. Students should ensure collection of E-receipt of successful payment generated in the online system or SMS sent from the University to their registered mobile no. or through e-mail to their registered e-mail id of candidates with "Successful" payment status. Mere receipt of SMS from own bank is not sufficient to ensure successful payment.
15. University will not take the responsibility of any payment failure caused due to network problems. So, candidates are advised to check their "Successful" Payment status.
16. Candidates who have not paid the requisite admission fees as per the previously published admission notification and merit lists will not be considered in the session.
17. If there is no candidate in the UR-DA, SP Category, then the seat will be transferred to the UR Category. Under similar circumstances, seats of DA-SC, DA-OBCA will be transferred to SC and OBCA Category respectively. 10. As per the reservation rules vide Govt. Order No.: 07-Edn (U)/1U-89/13.- dated. 2nd January, 2014 "for admission to different courses, an SC or ST candidate getting admission should have obtained in the previous examination; qualifying marks not lower by more than 25% of the marks obtained by the last candidate of the general category. In case of OBC-A and OBCB the candidate getting admission should have obtained in the previous examination; qualifying marks not lower by more than 10% from the marks obtained by the last candidate of the general category."
18. Guidelines of Inter-Transferability/Conversion of Reserved Seats:
 - 18.1 In case seats reserved for S.C. Category remains vacant for want of eligible candidates, seats will be filled up by the eligible candidate from the list of S.T. Category and vice-versa. If the seats of reserved Category remain vacant even invoking the principle of inter-transferability may be converted to seats under UR Category as per Govt. Rules.
 - 18.2 In case seats reserved for OBC-A Category remains vacant for want of eligible candidates, seats will be filled up by the eligible candidate from the list of OBC-B Category and vice-versa. If the seats of reserved Category remain vacant even invoking the principle of inter-transferability may be converted to seats under UR Category as per Govt. Rules.
19. The University reserves the right to rectify the list of candidates selected for admission in the event of detection of any inadvertent error, before or after payment of admission fees including cancellation of admission.
20. As per the directives of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India, it is notified that if any incident of ragging comes to the notice of the authority, the concerned student shall be given liberty to explain and if his explanation is not found satisfactory, the authority would expel him from the institution.

21. For subjects with multiple centre of learning (BU campus and affiliated colleges), candidates will be upgraded on the basis of merit, preference given by the candidate and seats available in the centre of learning. The candidates who opt for upgradation should contact the HoDs/TiCs of the respective centre of learning at the upgraded centre since due to upgradation and their acceptance therein, their previous allocation stands cancelled. The upgraded candidates have to pay admission fees as per the following:

21.1 If the admission fee of the centre where the candidate has been upgraded is more than the admission fees of the centre from where the candidate is being upgraded, the candidate has to pay the balance amount of the admission fees of the centre where the candidate has been upgraded.

21.2 If the admission fee of the centre where the candidate has been upgraded is lesser the admission fees of the centre from where the candidate is being upgraded- the candidate has not to pay any amount. The remaining amount will be refunded to the concerned candidates in due course as per university rule.

22. Selected candidates of the provisional merit list can get access for payment by logging in into the dashboard of the admission portal of The University of Burdwan by putting their applicant id and password.
