ADMISSION NOTIFICATION

A walk-in admission process for admission to the 2-year, full-time M Tech course in Electronics and Communication Engineering (Microwaves) (2021-2023 Session) will be held as per the following schedule to fill up the remaining vacant seats. The course runs under the Department of Physics, The University of Burdwan and is approved by AICTE. Interested candidates are requested to take part in the admission process.

Date of Selection Process: 16 November, 2021(Tuesday)

Time schedule:

- 1. Registration and document verification: 11:00 12:00 noon (Venue: Department of Physics, The University of Burdwan)
- 2. Written Test: 12:15- 13:15 pm (MCQ type; Venue: Department of Physics, The University of Burdwan)
- 3. Interview of candidates: 14:00 pm onwards
- 4. Publication of Merit List: 17 November, 2021 (in BU Website and Dept Notice Board)
- 5. Date of Admission: 18 November, 2021 (details would be provided along with the Merit List) **Eligibility for taking part in the Admission Process**
- **1.** B.E. or B. Tech. Electronics/ Electronics and Telecommunication Engg./ Electronics and Communication Engg./ Radio Physics/ Electronics/ M.Sc. in Electronics/ M.Sc. in Physics with Advanced Papers in Electronics with at least 50% (45% for candidates belonging to reserved categories) marks in aggregate or equivalent. Candidates awaiting their final result may also apply provisionally subject to production of Final Result before 31 December, 2020.
- 3. The applicants would be classified in three categories *viz*. **Category A:** GATE-qualified BE/B.Tech. candidates, **Category B:** Sponsored Candidates having at least 2 years' working experience in related field after passing out and **Category C:** Non-GATE BE/B.Tech candidates.
- 4. Candidates falling under category C will be considered for admission **only if** seats remain vacant after admission of candidates under Categories A & B. An online test of one hour duration will be held to prepare a short list of candidates falling under category C.
- 5. **Selection criteria**: Merit of selection of the candidates under different categories would be determined on the basis of the following: **For Category-A**: GATE Score (70%), marks in B.E./B.Tech (10%) and performance in the interview (20%);For **Category-B** (**Sponsored**): Performance in the interview and work experience; **For Category-C**: Marks of an **MCQ** test (70%), marks in B.E./B.Tech (10%) and performance in an interview (20%).
