Sir,

With reference to above I am to convey approval of the State Board for the final year project work, based on the project evaluation meeting held on 08/07/2020, for the above cited project and sanction a financial assistance of Rs. 3,38,000.00 (Rupees Three Lakh Thirty-Eight Thousand Only), under the following terms & conditions:

A) Name of the Project: Investigations on the Algal biodiversity of Himalayan districts of West Bengal.

B) Scope of the Project:

- To document the diversity of algae of the Himalayan districts of WB Darjeeling, Jalpaiguri and Alipurduar;
- To investigate the distribution (spatial & temporal) of algae and their habitat preferences together with their role as indicators of the environment;
- To examine the multiplicity factors involved in their distribution;
- To quantify the species concerned and the threats on those;
- To understand the correlation between the physico-chemical parameters and their occurrence and reproduction;
- To understand the relationship with other plants;
- To characterize the biodiversity hot spot in terms of algae and associated plants
- To prepare a monographic account of these micro-organisms considering all the utilitarian aspects.

Attention may be drawn to the comments of the Expert on first year's activities:

- Collection spots in case of Darjeeling district needs to be more randomized covering diverse habitats.
- Considerable number of species have been collected during the field study but their role as bioindicators, correlation with physico-chemical parameters, relationship with other plants and characterization of biodiversity hotspots in terms of algae have to be addressed.

C) Area to be studied: Himalayan districts of West Bengal Darjeeling, Jalpaiguri and Alipurduar.

D) Total duration of the Project: 2 (two) years.

E) Financial Assistance for the Project [2nd Year]

- a) Rs. 3,38,000.00 (Rupees Three Lakh Thirty-Eight Thousand Only) inclusive of all.
