With reference to your application dated 21.06.2022 through Teacher-In-Charge, Biotechnology for joining in Research Fellowship, I am to inform you that you have been selected as a U.G.C Junior Research Fellow in the Department of Biotechnology of this University.

The Fellowship will be governed by UGC guidelines, ("The tenure of Fellowship is initially for two years under the JRF scheme. Upon expiry of this period, the work of the Fellow will be evaluated by experts. 
