The University/Institution/College shall update the information in the master data regarding monthly payment confirmation, MSA, registration/resignation etc. of the beneficiaries on monthly basis. Based on the data updated on UGC web portal by the concerned university/Institution/College, the payment of the fellowship will be made to the beneficiaries. It may also be noted that UGC has proposed to link "AADHANAA" with bank account of student so that there can be direct cash transfer and effective disbursement of fellow ship monies to bank account of the awardee. In this regard, Ministry/UGC has already requested the university to fully transfer in Aadhan anadhan vide D.O. No. 7-14-24/2024 (CPP-II) dated 11.01.2024.
